Governors Report to Parents 2022/2023

On behalf of the governors at Oakhill we would like to take this opportunity to express our thanks for your continued support this year.

As a governing body we have worked very closely with the headteacher and the school senior leadership team to drive the strategic development of the school and raise standards of achievement. We helped with the setting of the school's vision, aims and objectives and we approved the school budget.

We met each term as a Full Governing Body where we have paid particular attention and focus on every child's progress and achievement across each year group.

The Oakhill governing body is made up of three committees that meet once a term and prepare reports which are fed back and reviewed at our meetings.

These committees are.

- Strategic Committee this meeting took place at the commencement of the school year and we looked at the strategic vision and how the objectives from this aligned with the schools development plan
- Audit and Finance Committee these meetings look at finance, premises, health and safety and staffing issues.
- Curriculum, Quality and Standards Committee this committee meets each term as it is
 essential that governors have a good knowledge and understanding of the curriculum and
 progress being made by each child across every year group. Some of the areas looked at
 during this year included: receiving reports on subject peer reviews; updates on the new
 assessment process in the Early Years Foundation Stage of the school; focussed on
 reading across the school; monitored progress in phonics; had discussions around ensuring
 access to the curriculum for every child and delivering mentoring programmes; reviewed
 "cohort stories" which helped us to understand data and will build a "whole school" picture.

Our chair of governors has the statutory role for SEND and Safeguarding and meet with the designated staff every half term and provide a written report back to the full governing body.



















We are once again proud to be part of such a caring and hardworking school, all staff have worked hard and supported your children's progress and attainment, they continuously strive for the best outcomes for the pupils at Oakhill. It is clear there is a dedication to creating a happy, safe learning environment where we have seen all of the pupils thrive.
